

AUTO DOSING

✓ GOOD LAUNDERING GUIDE

Auto dosing guidelines

- ✓ Regularly check levels in containers
- ✓ Select correct wash programmes
- ✓ Clean any spills immediately
- ✓ Report any issues with dosing equipment as soon as possible
- ✓ Do not tamper with dosing unit settings – these have been specifically set for your requirements
- ✓ Check tubes are fully inserted into the drums

Hygiene

- ✓ Wash hands regularly
- ✓ Cover any cuts and wounds with waterproof dressings
- ✓ Wear protective clothing when handling soiled laundry
- ✓ Regularly disinfect all surfaces and machines
- ✓ Never sort laundry on the floor
- ✓ Do not consume food or drink in the laundry

Equipment guidelines

- ✓ Always select the relevant wash programme
- ✓ Do not under or overload machines
- ✓ Clean filters regularly
- ✓ Do not stop a cycle before it is finished
- ✓ Do not leave items in washer or dryer overnight
- ✓ Do not forward cycle

Good Practice

- ✓ Use a sluice cycle for soiled linen
- ✓ Never open red laundry bags containing infected/foul laundry
- ✓ To prevent cross contamination, never mix infected/foul laundry
- ✓ To avoid excessive creasing do not over dry
- ✓ Sort and fold laundry quickly to minimise ironing and cross infection
- ✓ Do not use conditioner on Kylies or incontinence products
- ✓ Wash red bags at 65° for a minimum of 10 mins or 71° for not less than 3 mins.

COSHH

- ✓ Follow manufacturers instructions
- ✓ Wear protective clothing
- ✓ Never mix chemicals
- ✓ Store chemicals safely
- ✓ Clean up spillages immediately
- ✓ Be COSHH aware - know where to find safety data sheets
- ✓ Use common sense when handling chemicals
